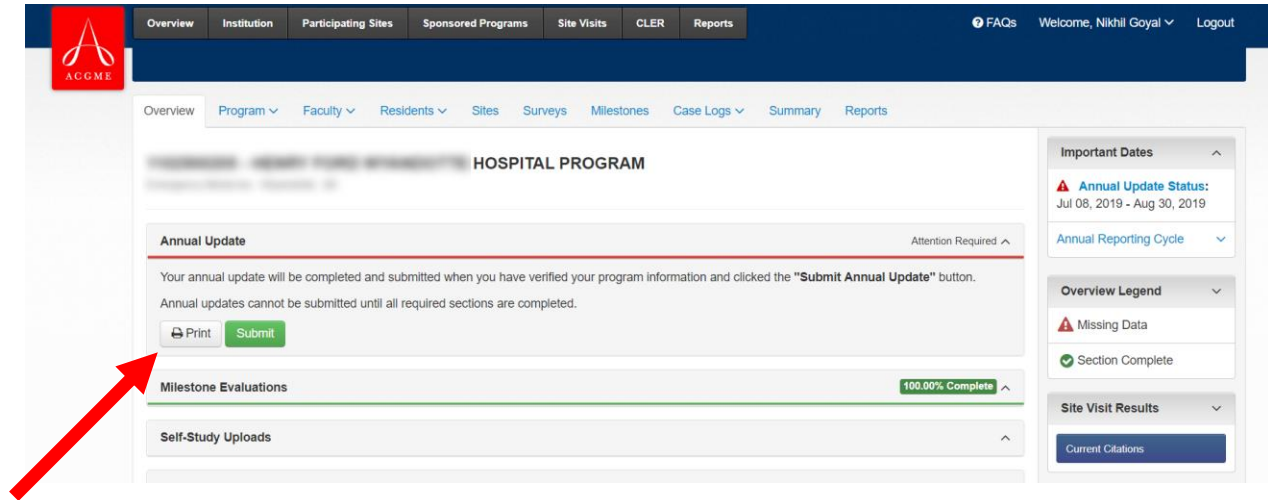


AUSAM (v2) Instructions

1. Log into ADS
2. Click the button marked "Print" under the "Annual Update" section



3. Wait for a new window to appear
4. Hold down the **Ctrl** key and press and release the letters **U, A, C** in sequence (Safari: Option+Command+U, then Command+A, Command+C)
 - This will display the page in HTML format, highlight all the code and copy it to the clipboard
 - Nothing may appear to happen after you press the C key
